1. The Government of Uganda has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Competitiveness and Enterprise Development Project (CEDP-), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
  2. The consulting services ("the Services") include Consultancy Services for Design and Supervision of Construction Works at the Uganda Museum.
  3. Private Sector Foundation Uganda (PSFU) through the Competitiveness and Enterprise Development Project now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are as follows:
    - a. At least 8 years' experience in undertaking related assignments.
    - b. Experience of at least 3 assignments of similar nature and scope that is in the design and construction supervision of museums or heritage centers.
    - c. Experience of at least 2 assignments in Sub-Saharan Africa or other countries with similar conditions to Uganda.
    - d. Submit the firm's organogram to demonstrate the firm's technical and managerial capability.
    - e. Availability/presence in the Consultant's firm of the following expertise: an Architect, Conservation Architect, Civil (Structural) Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Electrical Engineer, Land Surveyor, Quantity Surveyor, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Engineer, Environment Management Expert, and Social Safeguards Expert.
  4. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers", dated July 2016 revised November 2017 and August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
  5. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications. Consultants shall indicate clearly in the Expression of Interest whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
  6. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
